 that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
 incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2 of the second part 2 heirs and assigns,
 against said part 1 of the first part 1 their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
