

## Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

This Indenture, Made this 9th day of September, 1910 A. D., 19  
 between Robert K. Shipman and Lino Shipman, husband and wife  
 of Tulsa

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

Ella J. Davis of Tulsa, Oklahoma party  
 of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
 Three hundred and Dollars,  
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,  
 her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot numbered two of Block numbered eleven of Highland  
 First Addition to Tulsa Oklahoma according to the official  
 plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in  
 any wise appertaining forever.

And said Robert K. Shipman and Lino Shipman for themselves and  
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,  
 that at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and in-  
 feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;  
 that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and  
 incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns,  
 against said party of the first part, their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
