This Indenture, made this 20th day of May A. D. 1908
between W.R. Ritchie, Trustee

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred fifty and 00 Dollars,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part,
their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot 10 in block 8 in Baird's Addition to the town of
Tulsa, said County and State.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said Grantor for himself, his
heirs, executors or administrators, doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said parties of the second part,
that at the delivery of these presents, he is lawfully seized in full own right of an absolute and in-
defeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns,
against said party of the first part, his heirs, and and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
