

## Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

This Indenture, Made this 24<sup>th</sup> day of August A. D. 1910  
between Annie B. Orentt and Samuel A. Orentt her Husband

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and A.C. Sawyer

of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$325<sup>00</sup>  
Three Hundred Twenty-five and no/00 Dollars,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said party of the second part,  
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Twelve (12) in Block Twenty Seven (27) of the  
Park Place Addition to the City of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
any wise appertaining forever.

And said Annie B. Orentt and Samuel A. Orentt her Husband  
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,  
that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and in-  
feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;  
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and  
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, heirs and assigns,  
against said parties of the first part — their heirs, and and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
