

Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

CONTRACT

This Indenture, Made this 19th day of September A. D. 1910
between H. M. Rose (a single man)

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and J. C. Lashier

of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One thousand, eight hundred and no^o dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do^{es} by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The Northerly thirty (30) feet of lot no. Five (5) and the Southerly ten (10) feet of lot no. Six (6) in Block No Twenty-seven (27) of the original town of Tulsa, Oklahoma, said forty (40) feet frontage to be uniform the length of one hundred and forty (140) feet to the alley, according to the official feet and survey thereof; more particularly described as part of lots five (5) and six (6) in Block Twenty-seven (27) described as all that part of lot five (5) which abuts lot six (6) and has a frontage of thirty (30) feet on Boston Avenue, and extends one hundred and forty (140) feet to an alley with a uniform width of thirty (30) feet, and all that part of lot six (6) which abuts lot five (5) and has a frontage of ten (10) feet on Boston Avenue and extends one hundred and forty (140) feet to an alley with a uniform width of ten (10) feet, in the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official feet and survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said H. M. Rose (a single man), for his heirs, executors or administrators, do^{es} hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents, he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; Except all special tax assessments for street paving, and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, his heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
