

## Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

COMPLETED

This Indenture, Made this 21 day of August A. D. 1910  
 between James M. Blinell and Mellie Blinell, his wife, of La Salle  
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Henry T. Jerald  
 of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two thousand (\$2000.00) and no<sup>o</sup> Dollars,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part,  
 said heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east one-half of lot four (4) in Block one hundred  
 sixty nine (69) according to the original plat of the City of Tulsa.  
 The above described property is not the homestead of the  
 grantor and never was.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
 any wise appertaining forever.

And said James M. Blinell and Mellie Blinell  
 for their heirs, executors or administrators do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part,  
 that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and inde-  
 feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, to and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;  
 that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and  
 incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except one certain mortgage dated June 22,  
 1906.

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part heirs and assigns,  
 against said part of the first part their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
