 any wise appertaining forever.

 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2d of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and inde-
 feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
 that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
 incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; without exceptions

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2d of the second part her heirs and assigns,
 against said part 1st of the first part, of their heirs, and and all every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
