

## Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

This Indenture, made this 19th day of September A.D. 1910  
 between A. O. Grader and wife, Ethel May Grader of  
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and D. B. Cowan of Tulsa County in the  
 State of Oklahoma of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
 One Thousand and no<sup>o</sup> less than <sup>one</sup> hundred and <sup>no</sup> less than <sup>one</sup> hundred dollars, to be paid by the said party of the second part,  
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do <sup>hereby</sup> grant, release and confirm, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
 Territory of Oklahoma, to wit:

Lots 17 and 18 in Block 79 in the incorporated town of  
 Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
 unto the said part of the second part his heirs and assigns  
 any wise appertaining forever.

And said party of the first part, and his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns  
 for himself and his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,  
 that at the delivery of these presents, lawfully seized in <sup>own right of an absolute and inde-</sup>  
 feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances,  
 that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and  
 incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns,  
 against said party of the first part, <sup>his</sup> heirs, and all other person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, as my first  
 title, by <sup>any</sup> power under the said party of the first part his heirs or assigns, first
