COMPARED

This Indenture, Made this 13th day of Oct A. D., 1910 between M. H. Brown of Bisby Okla. of

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and M. A. Brown widow of Bisby Okla. of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of (\$1.00) One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations and the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do es. by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided one half interest in and to the South West quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Four (4) Township Sixteen (16) North of Range Thirteen (13) East Containing in all 80 acres more or less as the case may be according to the U. S. Govt survey thereof same being the allotment of Nettie Brown, deid.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said M. H. Brown the heirs, executors or administrators, do es. hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and inalienable estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part her heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part her heirs, and all every person, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
