COMPARED

This Indenture, Made this 8th day of October A. D. 1910,

between A. P. Evans and P. A. Evans, his wife)

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Board of School Directors of School District No. Twenty-one, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That said part first of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Thirty-five (\$35.00) and 75 cents Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part, and their successors in office, heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A rectangular piece of land bounded and described as follows: To wit: Beginning at a point at the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of section twenty-seven (27) township nineteen (19) north, range eleven (11) east, thence running north along the section line 308.7 feet, thence running east 208.5 feet thence running south 302.7 feet, thence running west 208.5 feet to the point of beginning and containing in all one and one half acres, more or less.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said A. P. Evans and P. A. Evans, his wife for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part, heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
