WITNESSETH, The said part of of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two thousand (\$2000.00) and no Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do all by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of        and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided one third (1/3) interest in and to the north half of section nine (9) T. 15 N. R. 13 E. and west half of west half of southwest quarter sec 4. and west half of southeast quarter of southwest quarter of sec 4 and west half of east half of southeast quarter of southwest quarter of sec 4 T. 15 N. R. 13 E. and being an undivided one third (1/3) interest in three hundred and ninety (390) acres more or less, same not being the homestead or any part thereof of the first part.
