COMPARED

This Indenture, Made this 15th day of July 1910  
between Lelia M. Henley, a single woman

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Robert D. Dawson

of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The west half (½) of the northeast quarter (4) of the northwest quarter (4) of section one (1) township twenty-two (22) range twelve (12) containing twenty acres more or less according to the old survey thereof

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Lelia M. Henley for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents shall lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part, their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
