This Indenture, Made this 2nd day of August, 1912, A. D., 19

WITNESSETH, The said part of of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two thousand six hundred and no (2600.00) Dollars,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of of the second part,  
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The south one half (1/2) of northwest quarter (NW 1/4) of Section  
thirty five (35) township twenty two (22) north range thirteen (13) east  
of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing eighty acres more  
or less.

This deed is given subject to a certain mortgage for \$1,000.00  
in favor of Luella R. Stewarts, of Wellington Kansas, the same  
to be assumed by party of second part, and is a part of the purchase  
price herewith.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
any wise appertaining forever.

for his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of of the second part,  
that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and inde-  
feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;  
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and  
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; excepting as above set forth.

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of of the second part his heirs and assigns,  
against said part of of the first part and their heirs, and and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
