

## Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

This Indenture, Made this 12th day of August A. D. 1910  
between Carrie Rogan and S. J. Rogan, her Husband of

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and E. Kersey, F. W. Robinson, J. C. Thomas  
and J. A. Coffle of the same place, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$1,000.00  
Eleven Hundred and no/100 Dollars,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part,  
their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

That certain tract of land beginning at the northwest corner of section 29  
Township twenty one 21 North, Range 13 East, thence running Eleven (11) chains  
South thence running Ten (10) chains east, thence running Eleven (11) chains north  
thence running Ten (10) chains west, to the point of beginning, containing Eleven  
(11) acres, more or less; same being part of the allotment of Carrie Rogan (En-  
rolled as Carrie Torrey) a Cherokee Citizen of the one-sixteenth blood, and  
whose roll number is 30315. The said E. Kersey to have an undivided one-  
half interest in said tract, the said F. W. Robinson an undivided ten-  
twenty-fourth interest therein, the said J. C. Thomas an undivided  
one twenty-fourth interest therein and the said J. A. Coffle to have  
an undivided one twenty-fourth interest therein.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
any wise appertaining forever, also including all of the water rights therein

And said Carrie Rogan and S. J. Rogan for themselves and  
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said parties of the second part,  
that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and inde-  
feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;  
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and  
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns,  
against said parties of the first part and their heirs, and and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
