On This Indenture, Made this 11th day of November A. D. 1910
 between T. J. Hinckley and Florence B. Hinckley Husband and wife
 parties
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and S. N. Phillips
 party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and ~~one~~ ^{one} hundred Dollars,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
 their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided one eighth (1/8) interest in and to the northwest
 quarter of the southwest quarter of section thirty four (34) in
 township nineteen (19) north, range twelve (12) east of the Indian
 Meridian.

This deed is given subject to a mortgage of \$450.00 on the
 whole of the above described forty acres, the one eighth of which
 the grantee herein assumes.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in
 any wise appertaining forever.

And said T. J. Hinckley and Florence B. Hinckley
 for ~~their~~ heirs, executors or administrators do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents, ~~they are~~ lawfully seized in ~~their~~ own right of an absolute and inde-
 feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of ~~to~~ and ⁱⁿ all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
 that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
 incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that ~~they~~ will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part ~~to~~ heirs and assigns,
 against said parties of the first part ~~to~~ their heirs, and and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
