This Indenture, made this, 31st day of October A. D., 1910
between Willametta Ford and C. L. Ford her Husband

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other
valuable considerations, and Dollars,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot two (2) Block five (5) Friend and Gillette addition
to the City of Tulsa, according to the recorded plat.

(This conveyance is made subject to a mortgage dated October 18th 1909
executed by Willametta Ford and C. L. Ford her Husband to J. M. Berry to secure the
payment of the sum of \$5000.00 covering the above described premises
said mortgage being filed for recording in the office of the Register of
Deeds in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, October 18th 1909
at 3 o'clock P.M. and recorded in Book 57 Page 87 and also subject
to paving taxes against said lot which grantee above named
assumes and agrees to pay.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said Willametta Ford and C. L. Ford, her Husband
for themselves, their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
that at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and inde-
feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, to and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns,
against said party of the first part, their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
