 This Indenture, Made this 25th day of November A. D., 1912
 between Mamie Shirk of

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Ella Harner

of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other
good and valuable considerations and _____ Dollars,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and
 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north nine and six tenths (9.6) acres of the west ten and six tenths
(10.6) acres of lot three (3) of section seven (7) of township eighteen (18)
north and of range thirteen (13) east of the Indian Meridian
This deed is made to correct a certain deed given by the
grantor hereof (Mamie Shirk) as Mayme Sullivan a single woman, which
was intended to describe the lands above, said deed being dated
November 21st 1907 and was recorded in book 245 at page 129 of the
records of the office of the register of Deeds for Tulsa County, Oklahoma
on December 4th 1907 and in which deed the grantor's name was
spelled Ella Horner instead of Ella Harner.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 any wise appertaining forever.

And said Mamie Shirk
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own right of an absolute and inde-
 feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
 that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
 incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns,
 against said party of the first part her heirs, and and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
