

## Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

This Indenture, Made this tenth day of August A. D. 1910  
 between George W. Adams of the City of Tulsa in the County of Tulsa  
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Samuel F. Darr of the City of Hannibal  
 and State of Missouri

of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar  
 and other valuable Consideration and Dollars,  
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,  
 his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of block 2, except lots 16 and 17; all of Block 5 except lots 21, 22, 23 and 24 in Adams Addition to the City of Tulsa in the State of Oklahoma, and also the east 1/2 of block 3, except lots 23 and 24 in Adams Addition to the City of Tulsa, containing in all 60 lots situated in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County and State of Oklahoma

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Grantor, for himself and his heirs, executors or administrators, does hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents, he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part his heirs, and and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
