

Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

This Indenture, made this 26th day of November A. D. 1910
between David A. Shipman and Lizzie Shipman, husband and wife

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Robert H. Armstrong
of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eight Thousand
five hundred twenty and no/00 Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east half of the north west quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the east
twenty four (24) acres of Lot Three (3) and also the north nine and
sixtyths (9.6) acres of the west Ten and Six-tenths (10.6) acres of said
Lot Three (3) all in Section Seven (7) of Township Eighteen (18) north
and of Range Thirteen (13) east of the Indian Baseline Meridian Con-
taining 113.6 acres according to the Government Survey thereof
Grantors also hereby convey all their right, title and interest in
and to the oil and gas leases on said land and convey
with said land to grantees 100 acres more or less of
growing wheat on said land

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said David A. Shipman and Lizzie Shipman
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
that at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and in-
feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; ^{or being aforesaid and given less in favor of} at Pay 173 of the Record of the Register of Deeds Office, Tulsa County,
Oklahoma this day of this date given subject to the charge created by said oil and gas lease
and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns,
against said party of the first part, their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
