

## Deed Record, No. 87, Tulsa County.

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This Indenture, made this tenth day of August  
between George W. Adams of the City of Tulsa, of  
Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Samuel F. Darr of the City of Hannibal  
and State of Missouri, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and  
other valuable Considerations, and Two Dollars,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,  
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and  
State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The south half of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section  
fifteen in township two, Range fourteen East, The east half of the west half of the southwest  
quarter of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section eighteen in township  
nineteen, range twelve east. The south half of the south half of the southwest  
quarter of section thirty six in township twenty one, range twelve east, except  
ten acres off of the east end thereof. The south half of the southwest  
quarter of the southwest quarter of section fifteen in township twenty  
range fourteen east. The west half of the west half of the south half of  
the south half of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section  
sixteen in township nineteen, range thirteen east. The south half  
of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section eighteen  
in township nineteen, range twelve east.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
any wise appertaining forever.

And said Grantor, for his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,  
that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and in-  
feasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;  
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and  
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns,  
against said party of the first part, their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
