the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of Lot twelve (12) in Block Six (6)
in Green Lee's Addition to the town
of Owasso, Tulsa County, State
of Oklahoma together with all
improvements thereon.

To have and to hold the same together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever.

And said A. M. Parish & Ora Parish, his wife
for themselves, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
that at the delivery of these presents, they lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and infeoffable estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of, and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except taxes due for the year of 1909.

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns,
against said party of the first part, their heirs, and all every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
