the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part, of the second part,

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east half of the northeast quarter of section twenty-six (26)
township eighteenth (18) north range fourteen (14) east, containing 8 acres
more or less,

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining forever,

and said C. E. Lester and his wife M. E. Lester for themselves
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part, of the second part,
that at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and infeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances;
that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and
incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part, of the second part, heirs and assigns,
against said part, of the first part, their heirs, and all every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
