DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 23rd day of November, A. D. 1919, between

Rose Miller, a single woman

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

Jeffrey A. Miller

, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

One dollar and other valuable consideration and DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
her heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of *Tulsa*,

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

*The south sixtieth (60) acre of lot one (1) of section thirty-six (36)
township twenty (20) north and range fourteen (14) east, being the west
half of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of the north
east quarter of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of
section thirty-six (36) township twenty north (20) and range fourteen
(14) east and the west nine and 74/100 (9.74) acres of lot three (3) of
section six (6) township nineteen (19) west and range fourteen
(14) east and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of
the southwest quarter of section thirty-six (36) township twenty
(20) north and range thirteen (13) east.*

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
anywise appertaining, forever.

that at the delivery of these presents *and they are* lawfully seized in *her* own right of an absolute and indefeasible
estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,

of what nature and kind soever; *except* *mortgaged to the King Co. for \$900*
M.C. Duraway for \$126.00 on which the above property is in part security
and that *she* will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part *and her* heirs and
assigns, against said party of the first part *and her* heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
