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## DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 24 day of Jan A. D. 1911, between

Jemima Kinney and C. D. Kinney her husband

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and James Stout

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Three Hundred

and no DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,

his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Three (3) in Block Eighteen (18) in Owasso Okla  
said lot being 50 x 140 feet, more or less according to  
U. S. Government Survey thereof

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Jemima Kinney and C. D. Kinney her husband for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,

that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except taxes for 1910

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
