Jessie B. Bates & L. P. Bates her husband

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of thirty seven hundred fifty
(43750.00) DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part,
 her heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the west line of South Pennsylvania Avenue
 two hundred fifty (250) feet in an easterly direction from the northeast corner
 of Block two hundred and one (201) of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,
 thence in a northerly direction one hundred fifty (150) feet to a point in the east
 line of a right-angle lot, said street, thence running in an easterly
 direction along the east line of said alley of fifty (50) feet, thence in
 an easterly direction, following the south line of south hundred
 (12th) Street, to the southwest corner of lot several (D) in Block
 two hundred one (201) of the Woodlawn Addition to the City of Tulsa
 Oklahoma, thence in a northerly direction along the easterly
 line of said lot 7, to the place of beginning, the same being a
 portion of lot three (3) in block two hundred one (201) belonging

 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
 same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,

of what nature and kind soever; except to me, warrant dated Oct 27, 1910, made by Jessie B. Bates
and husband to W. C. Knutson, to pay 1000.00 to my notes of and a balance due
me 13.50, made by Jessie B. Bates and husband, dated Oct 27, 1910, to W. C. Knutson
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part her heirs and
 assigns, against said part of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
