DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 15th day of November, A. D. 1910, between
Thomas F. Meagher Jr. of Muskogee

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and
Frances Meagher, the wife of the party of the first part
 of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
One Thousand and other good and valuable considerations DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doeth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
her heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of *Tulsa*

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north fifty (50) feet of Lot Fourteen (14) Block twelve (12)
 of the Owen Addition to the City of Tulsa subject however
 to a first and second mortgage held by the Denver

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, forever.

And said *Thomas F. Meagher Jr.*
 for *her* heirs, executors or administrators, doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents, lawfully seized in ~~own~~ right of an absolute and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
 same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances;
 of what nature and kind soever;

and that *her* will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part *her* heirs and
 assigns, against said party of the first part *her* heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
