DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 6th day of February, A. D. 1911, between
Chase E. Dent and Evangeline Dent his wife

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and George F. Baggs

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) and DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Nine (9) in Block Twelve (12) of the Street Addition to
the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma according to the official
plat and survey thereof

Provided, that this deed is subject to a condition and
reservations binding upon the party of the second part,
his heirs or assigns that in no event shall the
second party, their heirs or assigns erect upon any
portion of Lot Nine in Block Twelve above described
a building to be used for residence purposes costing
less than \$2,000.

To have and to hold the same, together with all singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Chase E. Dent and Evangeline Dent his wife
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
that at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible
estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part their heirs and
assigns, against said parties of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
