## DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 3rd day of January, A. D. 1911, betweenTennarype Rolland, a single man, Creek Indian Citizen, Member

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and R. H. Kirk

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of five hundred fifty(\$550.00)and no DOLLARS,the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2 of the second part,his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa  
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:One undivided one-fourth interest in the southeast  
quarter (SE 1/4) of Section thirteen (13) of township sixteen (16)  
north and of range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and  
Meridian.To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
anywise appertaining, forever.And said 1for his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2 of the second part,that at the delivery of these presents he lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible  
estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the  
same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,  
of what nature and kind soever;and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2 of the second part his heirs and  
assigns, against said part 1 of the first part or their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.IN WITNESS WHEREOF, The said part 1 of the first part has hereunto set his hand the day and year above written.
