DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 17th day of December 1911, A. D. 1911, between
M. B. Shuttles and Eddie M. Shuttles of

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Thomas J. Dawson

of the second part;

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

\$1,000.00 DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,

his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa,
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Twenty acres of land described as follows: beginning
 at a point (1320) Thirteen hundred and twenty feet south of the South
 West corner of the southeast quarter of Section (18) Big Creek
 Township (19) south Range (13) Thirtieth East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma
 Thirteen east (1320) Thirteen hundred and Twenty feet from
 north (660) six hundred and eight feet; thence West (1320)
 Thirteen hundred and Twenty feet; thence South (660) six hundred
 and sixty feet to place of beginning subject to boundaries
 as now provided for all of Road all in Lot (3) three
 and the East half of the Southwest quarter of Section (18)
 Township (14) south Range 13, East Tulsa County, Oklahoma
 and all parts of the instrument of James Jefferson deceased.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, forever.

 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,

 same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
 of what nature and kind soever; excepting their vehicle known as Black and White and Thomas J. Dawson's car, which is at 23 Main Street thereof
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and
 assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
