DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$1765.00

 Consideration, less than aforesaid, and DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part,

 same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
 of what nature and kind soever;

and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part, her heirs and
 assigns, against said part of the first part, her heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
