DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 9th day of February, A. D. 1911, between W. A. Cook and J. L. Cook, his son, his wife,

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

~~One thousand dollars~~ and ~~200~~ DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: ~~One-half interest in~~ and the Lots six (6) and seven (7) and the south half of the southwest quarter of section Thirteen (13) and the north half of the Northwest quarter of section Twenty-two (22) all in township Nineteen (19) North of Range Eleven (11) East.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said W. A. Cook and J. L. Cook for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents, they lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, except certain mortgage indebtedness on said land of one-half of which the grantee assumed and further to pay the principal amount of \$1250 which the said grantee assumed and which said X and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
