WITNESSETH, The said part y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and Two Hundred and no 100 DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do as by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part y of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Seven (7) in Block Five (5) of Brady Heights Addition to the city of Tulsa Oklahoma as per the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

Lloyd him and his heirs, executors or administrators, do as hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part y of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents He is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;
