DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

COMPARSED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 28th day of December, A. D. 1910, between
M. A. Yankman and wife,
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and *Union Trust Company (a corporation)*
 of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
One thousand four hundred forty five and *00* DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
 its successors and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of *Tulsa*,
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The northeast quarter (1/4) of the southeast quarter
 (S.E.) of Section thirty-one (31) Township Twenty (20) north range
 Thirteen (13) east, less that portion of the southeast corner
 thereof taken by the Santa Fe and San Joaquin Railway Company
 for right of way. This deed made to correct deed given 5th
 day of April, 1910 by same grantors and recorded April 5th
 1910, Book 67 page 579 in the office of the Register of Deeds
 of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

* The said Trust Company is hereby authorized to plot
 dedicate and sell such land to such corporation or the
 funds received therefrom in accordance with the
 agreement entered into by and between the Union Trust
 Company and *M. A. Yankman*.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, forever.

And said *M. A. Yankman and wife*,
 for *their* heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents *they* lawfully seized in *their* own right of an absolute and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
 same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
 of what nature and kind soever;

and that *they* will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part *successors* and
 assigns, against said party of the first part *heirs* and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
