## DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,

*Leona* heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of *Tulsa*

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

*South forty two feet (42') of lot four (4) Block five (5)**North Texas according to the recorded plat thereof.*

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.
