## DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 6<sup>th</sup> day of January, A. D. 1911, between

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,  
his ~~heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa~~

 (S. 2) east thereof, the angle between (1) and (2) east containing about 30.54  
 acres more or less, and being a portion of the

 anywise appertaining, forever.
