DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 22nd day of November, A. D. 1912, between

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,

his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot one (1) Block seventeen (17) and lots four (4), five (5) and six (6) Block seventeen (17) and lots three (3) and four (4) Block forty six (46) situated in the townsite of Red Fork according official plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

for his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,

that at the delivery of these presents that he lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part his heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
