## DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 16th day of January, A. D. 1911, between

*Hugh R. McDivitt (Single Hand)*

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

*Charles E. M. Cheek*

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said part, of the first part, in consideration of the sum of *two thousand dollars*  
*(2000.00)* and DOLLARS,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party, of the second part,  
*his* heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of *Tulsa*

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

*An acre of land located in the 1/4 of the 16th section 19  
 Township 11 north Range 13 east, described as follows, to wit:  
 starting from the point 1 rod east of the left corner  
 of the 1/4 of section 19, Township 11 north Range 13 east and  
 running from section line 1/3 rod north thence east of 3/4  
 rods thence south 1/3 rods thence west along section line 1/3  
 rods to place beginning according to the U.S. Surveyor  
 Surveys.*

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
 anywise appertaining, forever.

for *his* heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party, of the second part,  
 that at the delivery of these presents, *that he is* lawfully seized in *his* own right of an absolute and indefeasible  
 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, to and in all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the  
 same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,  
 of what nature and kind soever;

and that *he* will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party, of the second part, *his* heirs and  
 assigns, against said party, of the first part, *his* heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
