DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 17th day of January, A. D. 1911, between*George Washington, a single man

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

One hundred fifty (\$150.00) and no DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,*Lee L. heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa*

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

*Lot four (4) of Block fifteen (15) in College Addition to
Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof*

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said *Grantor*, for *Lee L.* heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,that at the delivery of these presents, *Lee L.* lawfully seized in *Lee L.* own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;and that *Lee L.* will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, *Lee L.* heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, *Lee L.* heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.IN WITNESS WHEREOF, The said party of the first part has hereunto set *Lee L.* hand ^{first} day and year above written.
