 or in anywise appertaining, forever.

 for themselves heirs, executors or administrators, do        hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part ies of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate  
 of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,  
 clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and  
 kind soever; except any and all taxes that may be assessed and unpaid and except a certain Mort-  
gage to Farmers Home Savings and Loan Association of Okla. which the parties of second part agree to  
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part ies of the second part their heirs and assigns,  
 against said part ies of the first part        heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
