WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One (\$100) Dollar and
other good and valuable considerations and Corporation DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said parties of the second part,
its heirs and assigns, all of the following described Real Estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State
 of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning at a point One hundred sixty five (165) feet South of the
 Northeast corner of Section Twenty (20) Township Twentieth (17)
 North Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian thence
 running South Two hundred thirty one (231) feet thence
 running West Three hundred thirty (330) feet thence running North
 Two hundred thirty one (231) feet thence East to place of
 beginning according to the U.S. Government Survey
 thence

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging
 or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said J. C. Schrieker and Clara Schrieker
 for themselves heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said Corporation of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate
 of inheritance, in fee simple; of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,
 clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and
 kind soever; except oil and gas lease now existing on
said property
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said Corporation of the second part its heirs and assigns,
 against said parties of the first part themselves heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
