 second part, that at the delivery of these presents that he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate
 of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free,
 clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, with this judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and
 kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns,
 against said parties of the first part that and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
