KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we S. W. Marr, President and H. R. Oline Secretary of The New State Investment Company have caused the West half (E.1/2) of the East half (E.1/2) of the North West quarter (N.W.1/4) and the West Eighty-six (W. 86) feet of the East half (E.1/2) of the (E.1/2) of the North West quarter (N.W. 1/4) of Section Seven (7), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East to be surveyed, laid out and platted into streets, alleys, lots and blocks as is shown by the plat of J. C. Cobb filed in the office of the Clerk of the U. S. Court for the Twenty-eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, on the 4th day of October, A. D., 1906, and to be known as Forest Park Addition to Tulsa, Indian Territory.
