

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Carl C. Magee and Grace C. Magee, his wife, hereby dedicate to the use of the public the following named streets in Forest Park Addition to Tulsa, Indian Territory, viz:

All that part of Park Avenue between Magee Street and East Eleventh Street and the south thirty (30) feet of East Eleventh Street. Also the north thirty (30) feet of Magee Street between the alleys in block two (2) and block three (3) in accordance with the recorded plat thereof.

The description of Block two (2) and Lots seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11) and twelve (12) in Block three (3) as shown by said plat are with our consent and in accordance with our wishes as owners and proprietors thereof.

The right to lay gas and water mains and electric wires in said streets and alleys is hereby expressly reserved.
