RENTAL CONTRACT.

The South one half SE Quarter Section 25, Township 17 North, Range 13 East

The said party of the second part, for the use of said land agrees to pay to the party of the first part as rent one Hundred Eighty dollars per annum during the term of this contract payable as follows:

\$20.00 cash in hand and \$160.00 Jan. 1st, 1911, \$180.00 Jan. 1st, 1912, and \$180.00 Jan. 1st, 1913.
