KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, Whereas, on the 3 day of December A.D. 1909, the plaintiff, Gertrude E. Schaff, filed her petition in the District Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, Numbered 1688 on the docket thereof, against Emma Thomas, a minor, and Bettie Thomas, a minor, for partition of certain premises hereinafter described.
