ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

This instrument made and entered into this 5th day of July, 1910, by and between E. M. Arnold of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and C.E. Suppes and E.R. Minshall, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, cash in hand well and truly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and other good and valuable considerations, the first party has bargained and sold and by these presents does hereby bargain, sell and convey unto the second parties an undivided two thirds interest in and to that certain oil and gas lease executed and delivered on the 30th day of June, 1910, by Eddie E. Crossley and I.S. Crossley to E.M. Arnold, covering the following described land in Tulsa County Oklahoma, to-wit:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid undivided two thirds interest in and to the aforesaid oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created unto the parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, for the full term of said lease and the life of said leasehold estate, subject to the terms and conditions of said lease.
