ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS

Washington D.C. Apr. 27, 1910.

Whereas, Oce Dick an allottee of the Cherokee Nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described, land, to-wit:

South half (1/2) of Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Southwest Quarter (SW/4) and Northeast quarter (NE/4) of Northeast quarter (NE/4) of Southwest quarter (SW/4) of Section Ten (10) Township Twenty-one (21) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 30 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County.

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress Approved May 27, 1908 (Public No. 140), and the regulations prescribed thereunder hereby remove the restrictions from said above described, land such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
