

Interior has taken possession of the hereinafter described tribal property and has appraised the same at Eighteen Hundred (\$1800.00) dollars, and

WHEREAS, said property has been duly advertised for sale at public auction and the bid of O. H. Leonard of Tulsa, Oklahoma in the sum of Two Thousand and Seventy-five (\$2,075.00) dollars was the highest and best bid received, and

WHEREAS, The said O. H. Leonard has deposited the sum of Two Thousand and Seventy-five (\$2,075.00) Dollars to the credit of the Creek tribe of Indians with the United States Indian Superintendent at Muskogee, Oklahoma, and is therefore entitled to have such property conveyed to him,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the principal Chief of the Creek Nation do by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by law hereby grant, sell and convey unto the said O. H. Leonard, his executors, and assigns forever, all right, title and interest of the Creek Nation aforesaid in and to the following described property, viz:

South half (S/2) of Southwest quarter (SW/4) of Northwest quarter (NW/4) of Southeast quarter (SE/4); South half (S/2) of Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Northeast quarter (NE/4) of Southwest quarter (SW/4); Northwest quarter (NW/4) of Southwest quarter (SW/4) of Southeast quarter (SE/4); North half (N/2) of Southwest quarter (SW/4) of Southwest quarter (SW/4) of Southeast quarter (SE/4); Northeast quarter (NE/4) of Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Southwest quarter (SW/4); North half (N/2) of Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Southwest quarter (SW/4) of section Twenty-one (21) Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, together with all the buildings thereon formerly used for tribal school purposes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the principal Chief of the Creek Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the great seal of said Nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown.
