RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT
Creek Nation, Indian Territory.

(Sec. 17, act of June 30, 1902, 32 Stat 500)

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into, ^{in quadruplicate} this 25 day of December A. D. 1905, by and between Jane Davis, nee Littlehead, of Bristow, Indian Territory, Willie Littlehead of Sapulpa, Indian Territory and Whiteman Littlehead of Bristow, Indian Territory, sole heirs of William Littlehead, deceased parties of the first part, and Damon Oil Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the United States, in force in the Indian Territory, with its principal place of business at Tulsa, Indian Territory, party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 17 of the act of Congress approved June 30, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.
