KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Norah Kiely, Widow, of the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars in hand paid by The Aetna Building and Loan Association of Topeka, Kansas, do hereby sell and convey unto the said The Aetna Building and Loan Association, and its successors, the following described premises, situated in the County of Tulsa, and the State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot ten (10) in Block Seven (7) College View Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above granted premises, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said grantee and its successors, forever.

And the said Grantor for herself and her heirs, executors, and administrators covenant--with the said Grantee and its successors, that the said premises are free from incumbrances, and that she has a good right and lawful authority to sell the same and that she will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
